



# PARISH NURSE JANUARY

January 1, 2023 is the 7<sup>th</sup> day of our Christian church calendar. The Epiphany of our Lord will be on January 6, 2023.

Our Health News for January:

January 1 is National Healthy Living Awareness
Day. Include plenty of fruits and vegetables,
dairy products, lean meats, whole grains in your
diet and get exercise, avoid tobacco, alcohol
and street drugs. Get plenty of sleep and stay
positive—and don't let stressful things get out
of control, if possible. HAPPY NEW YEAR!

January 1-7, 2023 is FOLIC ACID AWARENESS WEEK. Folic Acid is a B vitamin necessary for cell growth. If taken before and during pregnancy, it can prevent 70% of some serious brain and spinal birth defects called neural tube defects, like spina bifida and anencephaly. Take a vitamin (with folic acid daily and eat fortified foods like cereals, pastas and whole grains. Also include leafy, dark green vegetables, beans, and citrus fruits.

January is National Cervical Cancer Awareness
Month. In order to prevent the main cause of
cervical cancer, young girls, before becoming
sexually active, need to receive the human papillovirus virus; it is given in three doses. Cervical cancer is preventable and can be treated effectively if caught early.

January is National Stalking Awareness Month.

Stalking is a criminal activity consisting of repeated following and harassing of another person. It is unwanted or obsessive attention by one or more people toward another person and is illegal in many states. In the U.S. approximately 13.5 million cases are reported annually.

January in National Human Trafficking Awareness Month. Human Trafficking is the trade of humans, usually for the purpose of sexual slavery, forced labor, or commercial sexual exploitation for the trafficker of others. This may involve providing a spouse, using force, or for the extraction of organs and/or tissues (e.g. ova). Human trafficking is a crime against a person—it is a violation of a person's rights. In 2020, 10,583 trafficking situations were reported.

Blood Pressure Checks will be given when needed.


